



ARTISTIC STAFF (BAND MEMBERS)

Original Kids Theatre Company produces 20 productions a year from a body of 300 young artists. The Fall season begins in September with shows running as late as January. The Spring season begins in January with shows running as late as early August. Junior level productions (Grade 4-8) rehearse twice a week (6 hrs) while Senior productions (Grade 8-12) rehearse three times a week (9 hrs). Hallowe'en and March Break productions rehearse three times a week (9 hrs) regardless of grade level.

Our Artistic Staff will work alongside the Artistic Director, Production Manager, Volunteer Coordinator, Technical Director and volunteers to ensure a positive experience for our young people to develop as both individuals and as artists. We are always looking for talented, experienced and driven artists who are passionate about working with young people in an artistic setting. With a playbill of 20 productions in a given season, we are always looking to expand our roster of artists to work with us!

All Artistic Staff members must undergo a police reference check. These are all honorarium paid positions.

Working in conjunction with the production's Musical Director, the **Band Members** will play their particular instrument for a production. Band Members must be reliable, punctual and must attend the technical and dress rehearsals of the production as well as all of the performances. Band members may be required for additional rehearsals at the discretion of the Musical Director. Applicants should specify which instruments they specialize in.

The Candidate

- Must display strong organization, leadership, effective communication skills. Experience in a summer camp environment would be considered an asset.
- Must be reliable and able to commit completely to their particular rehearsal and performance dates as created by the Artistic Director.
- Preference will be given to candidates who have experience teaching and working with young people in an artistic setting.

- The successful applicant agrees to abide by the rules of conduct, policies and procedures outlined by the Original Kids Theatre Company and its administrative staff.

Time Commitments

The Band Members must be available for all of the rehearsal times and performances as coordinated by the Artistic Director.
